**Gubernatorial Reappointment - Chickasaw Nation Election Commission
Mr. Claude Miller**


WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Sections 4 and 7 of the Constitution of the Chickasaw Nation, the Chickasaw Tribal Legislature shall enact rules and regulations pertaining to the Chickasaw Nation, and shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of real property, subject to federal law, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article XI, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Chickasaw Nation, the Governor shall perform all duties appertaining to the Office of Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation, and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Anoatubby has reappointed Mr. Claude Miller to a new term of office for the at-large seat on the election commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chickasaw Tribal Legislature hereby confirms Governor Bill Anoatubby's reappointment of Mr. Claude Miller to fill a term of office on the Chickasaw Nation Election Commission filling the at-large seat, beginning on on December 31, 2008 and ending on December 31, 2011.

Executed in regular session of the Chickasaw Tribal Legislature, meeting at Ada, Oklahoma, on October 17, 2008, by a vote of 12 ayes, 0 nays, and 0 abstentions.
