**General Resolution Number 26-011**

**Authorization for the Chickasaw Nation Boys and Girls Club to Participate in  
and Accept the Mentoring Program for At-Risk Tribal Youth from the Department of  
Justice Office of Justice Programs**

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Article VII, Sections 4 and 7 of the Constitution of the Chickasaw Nation, the Chickasaw Tribal Legislature shall enact rules and regulations pertaining to the Chickasaw Nation, and shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of real property, subject to federal law, and

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Article XI, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Chickasaw Nation, the Governor shall perform all duties appertaining to the office of Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation, and

**WHEREAS,** the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs (the "OJP") announced the Mentoring Program for at Risk Tribal Youth to establish a program based on one-on-one or group mentoring with at risk youth, and

**WHEREAS,** in 2008, the Chickasaw Nation Boys and Girls Club will work with the OJP to establish the mentoring program; and


**WHEREAS,** the OJP will provide the Chickasaw Nation Boys and Girls Club with funding to assist in the development and implementation of the Mentoring Program for at Risk Tribal Youth plans, including funding for training and equipment; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Legislature has determined that it is in the best interest of the community for the Chickasaw Nation Boys and Girls Club to participate in the Mentoring Program for at Risk Tribal Youth.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Chickasaw Nation Tribal Legislature hereby authorizes the Chickasaw Nation Boys and Girls Club to participate in the Mentoring Program for at Risk Tribal Youth and accept any funds on behalf of the Nation to support the Mentoring Program for at Risk Tribal Youth Program.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Governor or his designee is hereby authorized to sign any documents or take any other necessary action to carry out the intent of this resolution.
