Youth explore science, robotics, space, aviation and more. Participants must be Chickasaw citizens, First American citizens or children of Chickasaw Nation employees in the grade range listed for each camp. Chickasaw preference will be given.

CHICKASAW NATION AVIATION AND SPACE ACADEMY (CNASA) JUNIOR ACADEMY (GRADES 4-6) is an educational exploration of careers in science, technology and aviation.

CHICKASAW NATION AVIATION AND SPACE ACADEMY (CNASA) SENIOR ACADEMY (GRADES 7-12) expands on the mission of the junior academy and includes a three-day aviation experience. Participants explore aviation and space sciences with physics experiments, aviation career lectures, static aircraft displays, ground school introduction, preflight inspection and a pilot Q/A session.

FEMSTEM (**GRADES 6-12**) enables young women to engage with STEM educational paths and careers through various activities, field trips and speakers in related professions, encouraging them to pursue careers in STEM fields.

JUNIOR NATIVE EXPLORERS (GRADES 1-3) is an educational program designed to recruit and train young people in earth and natural sciences. Explorers can enjoy hands-on science experiments, presentations and discovery.

STEMBOTS! LEGO® (**GRADES 4-6**) introduces children to robot mechanics through the world of LEGO® building, coding and autonomous robot course navigation.

STEMBOTS! VEX (GRADES 7-8) builds on foundational robotics concepts, allowing students to construct and program VEX robots. Participants will develop problem-solving and teamwork skills while navigating obstacle courses and completing challenges.

STEMBOTS! FIRST TECH CHALLENGE (GRADES 9-12) allows students to engage in advanced robotics and engineering concepts, including hands-on design, 3D printing, CNC (computer numerical control) and CAD (computer-aided design) demonstrations, coding exercises and a team-based robot competition.

EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables at authorized farmers markets and farm stands are available from June through September.

SENIOR FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM (SFMNP) provides eligible Chickasaw seniors, Chickasaw Warrior Society members and Chickasaw citizens who are considered 100% disabled with EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables from authorized farmers markets and farm stands. First American seniors age 55 and older and seniors age 60 and older living in a First American household may also be eligible. Participants must reside in the Chickasaw Nation or the Oklahoma City area.



Each month between November and March, eligible Chickasaw seniors ages 55 and older, Chickasaw Warrior Society members and Chickasaw citizens who are considered 100% disabled can pick up food packages with fresh, frozen and shelf-stable fruits and vegetables. Chickasaw citizens participating in the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program are automatically enrolled. A scheduled pickup date is available once a month in Colbert, Oklahoma City and Tulsa.
