

Aspiring young artists are immersed in an exploration of various artistic fields, career preparatory programming and student-oriented skill development. Students can learn about contemporary and traditional Chickasaw and Southeastern First American art in a variety of mediums. The academy inspires exploration of the artistic process in writing, performing and visual arts.

An arts gala and showcase conclude the academy, giving students the opportunity to display their work and perform with their new and strengthened skills. The arts gala is a public reception to highlight the visual arts disciplines. The showcase is a public performing arts event incorporating all the performing arts disciplines into a final production.

The next academy will take place July 2026.

The **STARTING ARTS ROTATION** (**STAR**) (**AGES 8-10**) is a two-week day academy facilitated by professional artists. Students begin training in the arts with instruction tailored for their age and skill levels.

INTERMEDIATE (AGES 11-13) is a two-week day academy. This level begins training youth in their choice of artistic tracks: mass communications, performing arts or visual arts. Participants receive instruction tailored for their age and skill levels facilitated by professional artists.

CHICKASAW SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY MAJORS (AGES 14-18) is an immersive art instruction experience during a two-week overnight residential academy. Participants are housed in the East Central University dorms and have access to campus amenities, giving them a taste of college life as well. These students gain experience in their choice of mediums including drawing, painting, contemporary pottery, metalsmithing, creative writing, culinary arts, performance theater, dance, vocal music, digital arts, photography, printmaking, video production, fashion design and more.
