Own Violence, Take Responsibility, Act Respectfully Program (OTAP) is a 52-week domestic violence prevention program. It uses a cognitive behavioral approach with an emphasis on culture, history and First American traditions to prevent violence in the home. Participants must be a Chickasaw citizen or First American, or someone who impacts the life of a Chickasaw child. Participation can be voluntary or court ordered (as a result of violent behavior).

The farmers' market program provides EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables at authorized farmers markets and stands. EBT benefits are available from June through September.

**SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM (SFMNP)** provides eligible Chickasaw seniors, Chickasaw Warrior Society members and Chickasaw citizens who are considered 100% disabled with EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables from authorized farmers markets and farm stands. First American seniors age 55 and older and seniors 60 and older living in a First American household may also be eligible for these EBT benefits. Participants must reside in the Chickasaw Nation or the Oklahoma City area.

**WINTER FRUIT AND VEGETABLE BENEFIT** provides fresh, frozen and shelf-stable fruits and vegetables to people participating in SFMNP from November-March. A scheduled pickup date is available once a month in Colbert, Oklahoma City and Tulsa.


