ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE FOR CITIZENS AND HOUSEHOLDS

The **EACH Program** offers direct monetary assistance to eligible Chickasaw citizens living in households that have been negatively economically impacted by COVID-19.

ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

Eligible Chickasaw citizens may be awarded a one-time assistance payment of \$2,000 per citizen.

- Chickasaw citizens that have received unemployment benefits or have been unemployed at any point in time between March 17, 2020, and the date of application.
- Chickasaw citizens that live in a household with an annual income less than \$75,000 for single or married filing separate, less than \$112,500 for head of household or less than \$150,000 for married filing jointly or surviving spouses.
- Chickasaw citizens that live in a household which experienced housing instability or risk of homelessness at any point in time between March 17, 2020, and date of application.
- Chickasaw citizens that live in a household which experienced food insecurity at any point in time between March 17, 2020, and date of application.
- Chickasaw citizens that have experienced loss or reduction of income or employment, change in household or family circumstances, change in market circumstances, or due to medical needs.

Citizens that do not meet the above eligibility requirements may still qualify for the program.
