Recruitment and Retention Program Consent and Liability

Student Code of Conduct:

A primary goal of the Chickasaw Nation recruitment and retention program is to provide a safe environment. Students are expected to adhere to the student code of conduct while attending all program events, activities and/or are on the premises of the recruitment and retention program.

The use of tobacco, vapors or e-cigarettes, alcohol, or drugs in any form will not be allowed. Use of foul or abusive language, excessive horseplay, theft, misuse or abuse of public or private property, or disrespect of other students or staff members will not be tolerated. No individual, male or female, should be subject to unsolicited or unwelcome sexual advances or harassing conduct, either verbal or physical. Violators are subject to dismissal from the program and the premises.

Realizing these guidelines are not "all-inclusive," the Chickasaw Nation reserves the right to make adjustments to the student code of conduct.

The student code of conduct, and by extension this consent, is designed to ensure a program atmosphere that is enjoyable, collegial, and in keeping with the Chickasaw Nation mission "to enhance the overall quality of life of the Chickasaw people."

Consent to Transport:

Furthermore, I voluntarily agree to travel with program staff and other students to and from the official event(s).

Nothing contained in this consent shall be construed to waive the sovereign rights of the Chickasaw Nation, its officers, employees, or agents. This consent shall be performed within the applicable guidelines, resolutions, and ordinances of the Chickasaw Nation. State law shall not be applicable, nor shall disputes be subject to any authority outside the Chickasaw Nation.

Student grants consent for participation and transportation to all Chickasaw Nation recruitment and retention program events and activities.

Consent for Medical Treatment:

In the event that medical treatment is necessary, the student gives consent to the recruitment and retention program, its nominees and agents, and assigns permission to transport and seek emergency treatment, of the student, including decisions regarding the welfare of the student, such as medications and health assessments, up to and including mental and behavioral health care if necessary, while participating and/or on the premises of the recruitment and retention program.

Consent for Reproduction of Photographs and Voice:

I also grant the Chickasaw Nation, its agents and others working for it or on its behalf and their respective licensees, successors, and assigns the absolute right and permission to use, publish, reproduce, broadcast, and copyright my name, picture, likeness or any material based upon or derived therefrom, or to refrain from doing, in any manner, or media whatsoever for purposes of advertising or trade in promoting and publicizing the Chickasaw Nation. I agree that my picture or likeness or anything derived therefrom created by the Chickasaw Nation is owned by it.

Liability Release:

Student is participating in recruitment and retention program activities and/or using the program's facility solely on the student's own initiative, risk, and responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration set forth above, student agrees as follows:

Student shall not ever institute a suit, action at law, or any claim against the Chickasaw Nation for or by any reason of any damage, loss or injury that may occur, resulting from or arising out of participation in the above-described activities.

Student hereby indemnifies and holds the Chickasaw Nation harmless from and against any claims, liabilities, or causes of action for damages, compensation, or otherwise, and shall reimburse or make good any loss, damages, or costs that may result from or arising out of student's participation in the above-described activities.

Non-disparagement:

Student hereby stipulates and agrees that student may discuss non-confidential aspects of experience with the Chickasaw Nation; however, the student shall not in any shape, form, or fashion whatsoever, make any disparaging remarks of any sort or otherwise communicate any disparaging information about the Chickasaw Nation or the Chickasaw Nation's employees, officers or agents in their professional capacities herein to any third party, including but not limited to statements on social or any other media. Further, the student agrees to take no action of any nature which is intended, or would reasonably be expected, to harm the Chickasaw Nation or its reputation or which would reflect or reasonably lead to unfavorable publicity to the Chickasaw Nation.
