Performance, fees and payments:

The Chickasaw Nation dance students perform once in the spring. This is to gain performance experience and to share what they have learned with family and friends.

Parents/legal guardians are responsible for shoes, leotards, tights, dance bags and other items needed for dance class participation.

Costume fees are \$55 per dancer per class for the spring performance. Costume fees must be paid in full before the performance.

Tuition payments are due on the first of each month and are considered late after the tenth of the month. Cash, checks and credit/debit cards are all accepted forms of payment. After two consecutive months of not paying tuition, your student will be unenrolled from classes.

*Pre-pointe is a strength-building class done in ballet slippers and designed to prepare ballet dancers for pointe. All students in this age group are welcome, however, being enrolled in ballet is preferable.

**Pointe is for dancers who have permission from Katie Noble to wear and study the skill of dancing in pointe shoes.

***Advanced classes require previous experience with our studio as well as a high level of classroom etiquette. Placement is decided by the current instructor and student must be invited into the advanced class. All new students will start in the regular classes, there will be a two-week evaluation period in which it will be determined if any students should be moved to the advanced class.

*Performance group will audition two weeks after classes begin in fall 2026 and begin rehearsals the following week. This group will meet to learn and practice choreography to be performed in various events throughout the fall and spring semesters. This class requires passing the audition to join or by invitation from Katie Noble. The audition will be held at the studio, with the date to be determined. Dancers must be 10 years of age and older to audition and a member of the Chickasaw Nation Dance Studio.

*Jr. Performance group will audition in December 2026. This group will meet to learn and practice choreography to be performed at the youth art month (YAM) festival in March 2027. This class requires passing the audition to join or by invitation. Dancers must be 7-9 years of age and a member of the Chickasaw Nation Dance Studio.

Attendance commitment:

I understand and agree that by signing my student up for classes with the Chickasaw Nation Dance Studio, I am committing to having my student attend scheduled classes on time and for the full duration of the class for the 2026-2027 dance season to the best of my abilities. I further understand that failing to do so may result in my student's dismissal from the class and/or performance.

Chickasaw citizen priority:

I understand that this program is first and foremost designed for Chickasaw citizens and they will be given priority enrollment.

Parent/legal guardian consent, release, waiver of liability and indemnification:

In consideration of my student being permitted to participate in _____, I, on behalf of my student, myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby state that:

1. I believe that my student is physically and mentally capable of participating in event/program. I knowingly and freely assume any and all risks, both known and unknown, of illness, injury, death, damage and/or loss to my student, to others and/or to property which might be associated with or result from my student's participation in event/program, even if arising from the negligence of the Chickasaw Nation or others.
2. I release and forever discharge the Chickasaw Nation, its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, affiliates, representatives, successors and assigns of and from all liability, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to my student or property, however caused, arising or by reason of or during my student's participation in the event/program, whether prior to, during or subsequent to my student's participation notwithstanding that any claim may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the Chickasaw Nation, its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, affiliates, agents, representatives, successors and assigns.
3. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Chickasaw Nation, its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, affiliates, agents, representatives, successors and assigns, from and against any and all liability incurred by the Chickasaw Nation or damage to any property thereof arising as a result of or in any way connected to my student's participation in the event/program.
4. I grant permission to the Chickasaw Nation, its agents or employees to photograph, record, film and videotape my student during the event/program and to use such materials in any and all publications, educational materials, research, marketing, advertising, news media and web materials for future promotion of the Chickasaw Nation, its programs and events. I understand and agree that such materials, including all negatives, positives, digital images, prints, recordings or anything derived therefrom created by the Chickasaw Nation, will become and remain the sole property of the Chickasaw Nation and I will have no right or title to such items. If I should receive any print, negative, recording or copy, I will not authorize its use by anyone else. I will have no right of approval, no claim to any compensation, now or in the future and no claim (including without limitation, claims based upon invasion of privacy, defamation or right of publicity) arising out of any uses, alteration, distortion or illusionary effect or use in any composite form. I understand and agree that these materials may be kept on file and used for future purposes. I hereby agree to release the Chickasaw Nation from any and all liability arising from or in connection with the taking, use, publication or dissemination of such materials now or in the future.
5. I understand that the Chickasaw Nation is a sovereign entity and that the Chickasaw Nation does not waive any sovereign rights or immunities by offering and hosting this event/program.
6. In case of an accident or need for emergency medical attention, I give permission to the studio staff to take my student to a physician and/or other licensed practitioner and/or emergency facility of the Chickasaw Nation's choice. I understand that I will be responsible for all expenses for treatment provided to my student.
7. I understand that my student is required to follow all aspects of the program's code of conduct and dress code. Failure to adhere to those will result in dismissal from the event/program and all related events.

This consent, release, waiver of liability and indemnification is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the applicable laws of the Chickasaw Nation.
